The LFCC (Local Federal Coordinating Committee) is accepting applications from 501(c)3 organizations for the role of PCFO (Principal Combined Fund Organization) for the Johnson City/Mountain Home CFC (Combined Federal Campaign) for the 2009 Campaign year.

The PCFO administers the local CFC in accordance with United States OPM (Office of Personnel Management) regulations. A timely application must be submitted in accordance with the deadline established by the LFCC and include: a written and detailed campaign plan, with a budget, detailing all estimated costs required to operate the CFC; a statement signed by the applicant's local director or equivalent pledging to administer the CFC fairly and equitably, conduct campaign and fiscal operations separate from the applicant's non-CFC operations, and abide by the directions, decisions, and supervision of the LFCC and/or Director; and a statement signed by the applicant's local director or equivalent acknowledging the applicant is subject to the penalties and sanctions detailed in CFC Regulations § 950.403 and §950.603.

The deadline for completed PCFO applications is February 16, 2009. Completed applications must be received on or before the deadline by the Johnson City-Mountain Home CFC, 926 West Oakland Avenue, Suite 214, PO Box 4039, Johnson City, TN 37602-4039.

The LFCC will also be accepting applications from local 501(c)3 organizations interested in receiving funds through the 2009 CFC.
